

# Can fiber optic cables be stored together with electrical cables

Fiber optic cables should not be mixed with copper cables as the heavier copper cables can stress the fiber cables. Sometimes the fiber is hung below cable trays to protect it from masses of copper.

I'm not going to pretend to know all the nuances of the code but it appears it may be ok if the fiber optic cable is run with the current carrying conductors when they are associated.

If you want to run the fiber through the same conduit as the electrical cable, and the fiber is "ADSS" or has absolutely no metal in it, then you are totally safe.

Maintaining proper separation between power, data, and limited energy cabling is foundational to system performance, safety, and code compliance. Separation isn't just an EMI ...

Conductive optical fiber cables shall not be permitted to occupy the same cable tray or raceway with conductors for electric light, power, Class 1, non-power-limited fire alarm, Type ITC, or ...

Fiber optic is not impacted by the proximity with the power cable. There is no clearance required for this application. On the other hand, when fibre is run with a transmission line with towers, ...
