To avoid Electromagnetic Interference (EMI), ensure that power cables and instrumentation signal cables are routed in different trays with at least a 300-mm clearance.

What do I need, apart from an electrician, does the cable have to be buried or can it be put on poles. Can it just be plugged in or do it need a special connection to meterbox.

Since there is a cable tray in the trench, it seems obvious that the trench wasn't "designed expressly for holding wires, cables, etc", otherwise the cable tray would not be used.

Cable tray routing should be coordinated with building layout and other services (pipes, ducts, mechanical systems): Plan main routes along corridors, pipe racks, or dedicated cable ...

The thin-walled plastic conduit available in Costa Rica can only be used underground or encased in concrete aboveground. They cannot be used in (combustible) metal stud and gypsum ...
