If the employer protects employees from injury due to involuntary reactions from electric shock, a hazard exists if the resultant current would be more than 6 milliamperes.

Employees working within the flash protection boundary must wear nonconductive head protection wherever there is a danger of head injury from electric shock or burns or from flying objects resulting ...

Overvoltage protection by surge protection devices (SPDs) is not generally needed for a distribution board where a suitable rated impulse withstand voltage is declared by the manufacturer.

This chart categorizes different voltage levels and their associated risks, guiding workers and safety professionals in selecting the appropriate level of protection.

Standards are meant to set a minimum level of expectation. There are many circumstances that might create the need for more stringent requirements. Regardless of what ...
