

How to disconnect the fiber optic pigtail from the optical module

Before removing or installing a Transceiver Module you must disconnect all cables, because of leaving these attached will damage the cables, connectors, and the optical interfaces.

Pull out the optical module in the horizontal direction (please use even force when pulling out to avoid damaging the handle), and cover the optical module slot with a dust-proof cap.
