

If you glued the tip/ferrule assembly back onto the tenon, you trapped an air pocket inside, thereby causing hydraulic pressure. That air pocket could cause insufficient glue contact, ...

Turn off the main water valve to prevent leaks. Open the faucet to drain residual water. Use an adjustable wrench to loosen the compression nut. If stuck, apply lubricant and wait 5-10 ...

The one in my Morgan is always falling off every time I take the stem off for cleaning. No big deal since I have the pipe on a coffee filter and I can see where the ferrule lands. I don't remove ...

No, it can't be done and, for the sake or safety, don't even try. The tube material work hardens under the ferrule and, even if you could get the old ferrule off without making a single mark ...

One of my favorite tools for removing very stuck ferrules in the past (mostly from column nuts) is a Ferrule Removal Tool (see [Search | Agilent](#) ). Cheers, ... Was this helpful?
