Obstructions: The panelboard's working space must be kept clear and not used for storage. No obstructions like pipes, cabinets, or doors can block access to the panel.

If it's a reasonably recent panel, you should be able to buy a cover with a door. Those doors are firmly attached; I'm surprised to hear of one falling off. And the electrician would know it ...

Your safest bet: if the panel originally had a door covering the breakers, leave the door on the panel. If the panel didn't have the door, you don't have to add on to it to become code-compliant.

If the panel is rated (also called "listed and labeled" by NEC) to be installed without a door, then one is not needed. On the other hand, if the panel was designed and manufactured with a door ...
