Red or Amber: The router is having trouble powering on. A red or amber power light typically indicates a fault in the router hardware or a power supply issue.

No Power: If the Power light is off or red, check the power cord and ensure it is securely connected to both the ONT and the power outlet. If the issue persists, try resetting the ONT by ...

Every light on your Wi-Fi gateway has a meaning. Learn what each light means and how to use them to troubleshoot network problems.

A completely dark power light means the router isn't receiving power -- check the outlet, the power adapter connection at the router, and whether the adapter brick itself feels warm ...

If the power light on your ONT is off, it could mean that the device is not receiving power. This could be due to a problem with the power cord or outlet, or it could indicate a more serious issue ...

On the back of the router, check the On/Off button to confirm that it's powered On. If the lights are off despite your router being correctly plugged in and powered on, contact Technical Support at the ...

Make sure you are using the correct power supply (the one that came with the modem). Try restarting your modem if you haven't already, and be sure to wait at least 30 seconds before plugging it back in.

Usually the first light in a row or column, the power light signifies that the modem, ONT, router, or gateway is turned on and has power. The power light is usually solid but may blink when ...
