In many cases the use of pipe jacking techniques instead of open trenching will contribute positively towards workplace safety, the interface with the general public, and the local and wider environment.

Pipe-jacking method consists of jacking segmental pipes by means of a tunnel boring machine (TBM) and hydraulic jacks to complete an underground pipeline network.

Pipe jacking takes place when the operator on the pump unit's platform engages controls to extend jacking cylinders to advance the yoke and TBM and pipe along the skid base.
