

What to do if the ceramic ferrule comes loose

There is an upcoming article in RodMaker that shows how to easily determine where a ferrule is mis-fitting and how to cure it. There is more to this than meets the eye but every good custom rod builder ...

If the ferrule is stuck, you can gently tap it with a screwdriver to loosen it. If the fitting is leaking, check to make sure that the ferrule is properly installed and that the nut is tight.

Once the ferrule is removed, thoroughly clean both the pipe and the ferrule using a wire brush or sandpaper to remove any debris or corrosion. If the ferrule is firmly stuck to the pipe, try ...

This isolation is why double ferrule fittings can be broken down and re-made dozens of times during plant turnarounds, while single ferrules often deform and leak after their first reuse.

Turn off the main water valve to prevent leaks. Open the faucet to drain residual water. Use an adjustable wrench to loosen the compression nut. If stuck, apply lubricant and wait 5-10 ...

Fixing a loose ferrule doesn't require a degree in rocket science--just a few tools, a bit of patience, and some elbow grease. Follow these steps, and you'll have your clubs in top shape in no time.

Grab the ferrule, being careful of the sharp cut edges, and slowly pull it toward the end of the pipe. Since you cut the ferrule and separated it, it won't be as tight on the pipe so you can ...
